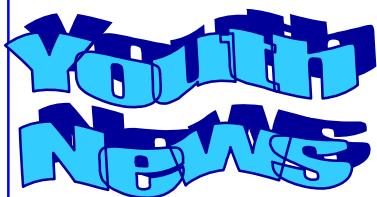


Ahoy Mateys!
